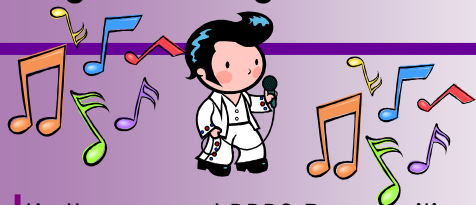

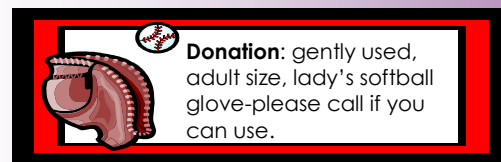
## Cynthia Mott Memorial Scholarship to be awarded

For the fourth year, one graduating Little Sister or Brother, going on to secondary education, will receive the Cynthia Mott Memorial Scholarship. Cindy was a big sister for 7 years before losing her battle with cancer. The scholarship was established the next year in her name, by her family. Cindy believed in the potential of all Littles to go to college or tech school and be successful adults.

The \$2000 scholarship is awarded to a graduating senior who was a Little Brother or Little Sister in a BBBS program for at least one year, is attending any accredited university or tech school this fall, and who has performed volunteer service in the community. The scholarship is administered by the Wisconsin Association of Independent Colleges and Universities. They review the applications and select the recipient each year.
