Now Accepting NEW VOLUNTEER Mentors - BIGS who live or work in Hartford, Slinger, Hubertus & Richfield

- ✓ This NEW mentoring program matches youth facing adversity between 6-11 yrs. old living in or around Hartford with a caring adult mentor in a group mentoring setting.
- ✓ There is no age limit to being a volunteer mentor – You can be as young as 16. The oldest Club Mentor Big is 80 years old!
- ✓ Male mentors are especially needed!
- ✓ Matches meet in a group setting 2x a month from 6-8pm on a Tuesday or Thursday evening at a designated location.
- ✓ Matches participate in planned group and one-on-one activities while supervised by staff.

Are you Eligible to Volunteer for CLUB MENTOR?

-  All volunteers must be at least 16 years old and have a valid driver's license as well as proof of car insurance.
-  Volunteers must complete a volunteer application, schedule & attend a volunteer interview, pass local, state & national background checks and attend training prior to being matched with a child.
-  Volunteers must commit to mentoring a child for at least a period of one year and be able to meet at least 2x a month for 2 hours from 6-8pm either on Tuesday or Thursday evenings at the Club Mentor site.
-  Volunteers must have a caring heart and be willing to mentor a child facing some type of adversity in their life such as living in a single parent low-income home, or who may be socially or academically challenged.

At Club Mentor Big & Little Mentoring Matches Will:

-  Participate in fun activities such as crafts, building projects, board games, foosball, and yard games. Matches may work on homework, learn about healthy lifestyles, and go on occasional group fieldtrips.
-  Get to know one another in a secure group setting while spending 1:1 time together exploring dreams, skills, interests and hobbies.
-  **HAVE FUN TOGETHER** while being supervised and led by BBBS staff.

Children with 1:1 Mentors Will See:

-  Increased self-confidence, self-esteem, improvement in academics and success at school and will be able to make better decisions and avoid risky behaviors. They also will also get along better with peers and adults.
